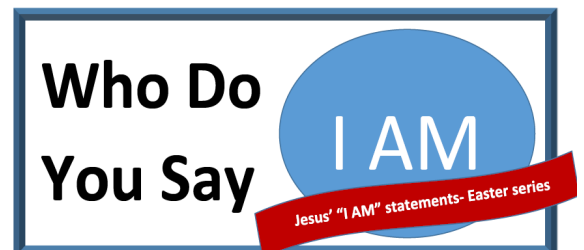
BIBLE READERS CHALLENGE - We are off to a good start! If you are not yet signed up, we would love to have you join us.

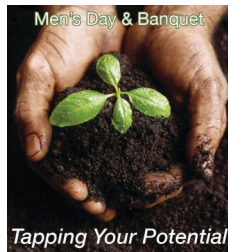

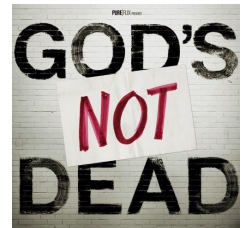
