# Youth Preacher's Post

Wow, we have some talented youth in our church! The youth helped lead the singing, share a special, and read scripture. We should be excited about the future of the church. I believe that these children and students are going places. How can I get my children and students involved in the church?

We offer five programs for all children from birth to Sixth Grade. Our Nursery Program is available for 0-2 year old children during the Sunday School and Worship services. Our Junior Worship Program is available for 3-4 year old children during the Worship Service. The Super Church Program is designed for Kindergarten through Sixth Grade children and takes place during the Sunday morning sermon. We offer a T.A.S.K Program for all children in grades K-6. T.A.S.K takes place on Monday's after school here at FCC Memphis. Our church bus picks up the students at the school. Our Sunday School programs are as follows: Nursery (0-2 yr. olds); Preschool (3-4 yr. olds); Early Elementary (K-3 grade); and Upper Elementary (4-6 grade).
