We were introduced to Ida Lewis on Sunday Morning. She took over the family responsibilities as the "keeper of the light" at the light house on Lime Rock Island at Newport Rhode Island way back in the 1850's. She remained at that station for over 50 years. She was only sixteen when she rescued four young men when their boat capsized. Se was sixty-three years young when she saved a friend who had fallen into the waters near the light house. It is believed Ida Lewis was responsible for saving at least 25 people over her career at Newport.

It is reported that Ms. Lewis was asked after one rescue about her bravery and courage. She had just risked her life pulling two soldiers from frigid water after breaking through unstable ice. Asked about her bravery and courage, she replied, "I don't know. I ain't particularly strong. The Lord Almighty gives it to me when I need it, that's all."

We are challenged in the scriptures to take the message of Christ to a world that needs saving. Might we be like Ida Lewis in that regard. I suspect part of the reason she was able to save 25 people was because she was always looking for those in peril. Her own admission about rescuing them was knowing the Lord gave her the strength she needed. Would you accept the challenge to identify one person in your life that needs to hear the Gospel message. Pray for them and watch for opportunities to talk to them about the Lord. Bring them to events and activities where they will meet your brothers and sisters in Christ. Trust the Lord to give you courage and the words you need to point your friends to Jesus.
